

MID-YEAR REPORT JULY 1 - DECEMBER 31, 2023




HUB EVENTS

Between July 1 - December 31, 2023, the Hubs hosted a total of <mark>53</mark> events.

- Approximately 6,248 individuals participated in Hub events
- 20 events supported academic success
- 26 events promoted health + wellness
- 46 events facilitated family + community engagement

MID-YEAR HIGHLIGHTS

- Improved communications, as evidenced by 72% open rate for Hub Happenings monthly newsletter
- Established a Schools as Community Hubs Strategy Council made up of 14 community leaders
- Strengthened family connectedness and community engagement through holiday events at each Hub, sponsored and facilitated by community partners and Hub leaders
- Hosted two Hub Town Halls to identify priorities that will drive programming and partnerships.
